

# Lake Powell Fishpro Challenge

## Event Specific Rules

### State Line Launch Ramp Lake Powell Utah

**Date:** May 8, 2021

**Location:** State Line Launch Ramp Lake Powell Utah

**Sign in time:** 4:00 am – 5:00 am AZ Time

**Anglers Meeting:** 5:00 am – 5:10 am AZ Time – Mandatory for all Anglers We will meet at the sign in area.

**Launching Time:** Not before 5:27 am (legal sunrise)

**First Flight:** 6:00 am AZ Time

**First Return Check in:** 3:00 pm AZ time

**Last Return Check in:** 4:00 pm AZ time

**Registration Deadline:** May 7, 2021 6:00 pm AZ Time

A park entrance fee, an America the Beautiful pass or a Glen Canyon National Recreation Area pass is required to enter Glen Canyon National Recreation Area. A watercraft fee is also required. [Glen Canyon Fees & Passes Information](#)

- 1. Sign in:** All anglers must have been pre-registered at this point. Only anglers already registered through the Fishing Chaos App will be allowed entry. NO ONSITE OR LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ALLOWED.
  - a. Anglers will meet at the bottom of the State Line Launch Ramp for sign in.
  - b. First in line will be first to randomly draw their Identifier. This will also be your number for your flight time.
- 2. Launching:** Since all PWC'S are prohibited from being under way on the water after dark or before sunrise, launching will not be allowed until 5:27 am.
  - a. Vessels may launch from State Line launch Ramp. If another launch ramp is used, then a vessel MAY NOT be underway before 5:27 am AZ time.
- 3. Identifiers:** All anglers must obtain an Identifier at check in. These will be drawn at random. This unique identifier must be visual in all fish photos submitted. **Any photo submitted without a legible Identifier will be rejected.**
- 4. Flight order:** Your Identifier number will be used to determine your order of departure from the wakeless area. There will be a specific area that you must pass between when exiting the wakeless area and when returning. If you fail to pass through this area, you will receive a deduction of 10" from your overall score.
- 5. Pre-fishing:** Fishing will be allowed up to May 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm Az time.

6. **Waivers:** All waivers are to be signed in person during sign in. It is recommended that all anglers review copies of the waivers which are available in the ULA Rules Standard. These waivers will be provided at sign in.
7. **Return Check in at end of fishing:** Each angler is to pass through the check in area at the beginning of the wakeless area upon returning. If you fail to pass through this area, you will receive a deduction of 10" from your overall score.
  - a. Angler deadline for return will be 8 hours 15 minutes after drawn flight departure time.
8. **Uploading Photos:** There is limited cell phone service at Lake Powell. If you are not able to upload your photos while on the water, there will be a "Hot Spot" available on shore at the check in location.
  - a. Anglers will be allowed time, until 5:00 pm Az time to upload photos.
9. **Legal PWC:** Here is a link to the requirements for a legal PWC at Lake Powell.

10. **Other Boaters:** Lake Powell is a busy lake. It is your responsibility to know and understand all boating rules. Here are a few tips:
  - a. Never pass within 150 feet of another vessel that is moving or stationary while you are motoring above wakeless speed, it is the law.
  - b. Obey all wakeless areas. Any angler who is spotted violating a wakeless area can be disqualified from the tournament.
11. **Announcement of winners:** Winners and prizes should be announced no later than 6:00 pm AZ time.
  - a. Winners must be present to receive prizes.
12. **COVID 19 Information:**
  - a. **Participants, organizers, guest, and visitors must wear a mask when registering, gathering for instructions or presentation, and scoring fish, when they are not on their PWC'S and on the lake.**
  - b. **All non-affiliated groups should maintain social distancing of 6' or more.**
  - c. **Permittee will discourage the formation of groups larger than three people.**
    - i. **Informational Requirements:**
    - ii. **If participants have any symptoms associated with the COVID-19 virus (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html>), they must identify themselves and be ordered removed from the event.**
  - d. **Participants will have access to the restrooms, and are requested to socially distance themselves while using those facilities.**
13. **Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention & Containment:** As a participant, each angler acknowledges that Lake Powell and other waters within the recreation area contain quagga mussels, an aquatic invasive species. The angler also acknowledges that the states of Utah and Arizona have legal requirements regarding the transport of vessels from affected/infested waters to prevent the spread of invasive mussels.

**NOTE: The Castle Rock Cut is not open. Be aware that to travel up the lake you must travel via the main channel.**
